It is a unique programming competition for students, between the ages of 8 and 16 from Lebanon and the MENA region, offering them the opportunity to compete in a fun and engaging environment while putting their coding, Design, and Teamwork skills to test.

- ∴ Submissions of APK and AIA Files: **February 22, 2020**
- ∴ Announcement of the shortlisted teams: **March 02, 2020**
- ∴ Pitch Day: **April 25, 2020**
- ∴ Announcement of winners: **April 25, 2020**

Guidelines

Submissions

- Students can choose to develop a quiz app, a rating app, a game app, or any other app type as long as it adheres to the competition theme.
- Files to be submitted through the following link:
www.geekexpress.com/competitions/app-inventor
- Only one team member must submit the APK and AIA files.
- No late submissions will be allowed.
- The App should be developed using MIT App Inventor online platform only.
- The App should be fully functional and bug free.

Pitch Day

- Shortlisted teams should prepare a pitch to present it in front of a jury on the day of the pitch. Presentation format will be shared with the shortlisted teams.
- Pitch Day starts at 10:00 AM and ends at 3:00 PM. All teams must arrive 30 min prior the start of the event.
- Presenters will have 7 minutes to pitch their app and to answer the Jury's questions.
- At least one of the team members should be available in Beirut on the day of the pitch. Online presentation will not be allowed.
- During the event, teams will be scored over 100 according to the following criteria:
 - 10 points for project relevance to the theme
 - 30 points for the algorithm used
 - 30 points for the app UI-UX
 - 30 points for the presentation
- One winning team is announced at the end of the Pitch Day.

Eligibility

- The competition is open to students between the age of 9 to 15.
- All team members must live in an Arab country.

Awards

- All students participating in the Pitch Day will receive Geek Express certificate of participation.
- The winning team will win a sponsored trip to attend the MIT App Inventor 2020 Summit in MIT, Boston-USA.
